Southern Waste Solutions agrees to discontinue legal action

Southern Waste Solutions has reached agreement with the Southern Beaches Conservation Society to discontinue legal action against the Society.

The dispute had centred on written communications sent by the Southern Beaches Conservation Society to current and potential customers of Southern Waste Solutions concerning the construction of a C-cell at its Copping landfill site.

Southern Waste Solutions Chair, Ron Ward, said given the C-cell was now entering detailed design work prior to inviting tenders for construction, it was agreed to discontinue the legal action.

“Southern Waste Solutions believes we have made our point with regard to the legal action and we now want to get on with the job of constructing the C-cell,” Mr Ward said.

“The legal action was a distraction from the process of getting the C-cell built, so we have reached agreement to discontinue the legal action.”
