ENVIRONMENT POLICY STATEMENT

- embrace innovation to deliver best practice waste management solutions, using environmentally sensitive products, practices and technologies where possible;
- minimise its environmental footprint by reducing the consumption of resources (energy, water and natural resources) through its activities and operations, and offset any gains in its footprint through innovation and increased investment in best practice;
- consider sustainability issues in the planning of capital works and major projects, with the intent to design sustainability and environmental protection into new projects/facilities from the outset;
- promptly address stakeholder expectations and community concerns by engaging with, and listening to, the community, customers, neighbours, industry groups and regulatory authorities; and
- ensure adequate resources are in place to implement this policy.
